## Verbal Spontaneous Problem

## CARS

(When the team enters the room, tell them that this will be a verbal problem)

JUDGE READS TO TEAM:

- 1) You will have 2 minutes to think and 3 minutes to respond.
- 2) Each of you has 7 cards. After each response, you will place 1 card in the container.
- 3) Questions count against your thinking time. You will respond in order. You may give responses until you no longer have any cards or until time ends, whichever occurs first.
- 4) Common answers will receive 1 point. Highly creative or humorous answers will receive 5 points.
- 5) Your problem is: Name unusual kinds of cars. For example, you could say, "convertible."

FOR JUDGES ONLY:

- 1) Provide 35 cards—7 cards per team member. Try to provide colored cards or cards that are somehow marked so that each team member's items are distinguishable from one another.
- 2) Look for unusual responses and always reward humor.
- 3. Examples of common (1 point) responses:
- \*Any kind of car or car model that actually exists or existed at one time--Camry, Mustang, Model T, Chevrolet, Ford, station wagon, SUV, etc.
- 4. Examples of creative (5 point) responses:
- \*Car as part of a word—cartoon, carving, carbon, carton, card, carpet, carburetor, carbonated, bicarbonate, scarf etc.
- \*Fictional cars—Batmobile, Herbie the Love Bug,
- \*Unusual vehicles that may not be thought of as cars: moon rover, dune buggy
